III. Purposes and legal grounds for personal data processing

We process Tech's personal data for the purpose of performing the services of Test, s.r.o. – development, production and sale of optical detection devices and consulting and inspection activities in the field of surface treatments. In some cases, the processing of personal data is necessary to fulfill the contract or is our legitimate interest.

Categories of personal data that are the subject of processing:

Address and identification data used for unambiguous and unmistakable identification of the data subject (e.g. name, surname, title, employer, ID number, tax identification number) and data enabling contact with the data subject (contact data - e.g. contact address, telephone number, fax number, e-mail address and other similar information), descriptive data (e.g. bank details) and other data necessary for the performance of the contract.



IV. Legitimate interests of the administrator

Our legitimate interests include:

If you want to be informed about something from us, it is our legitimate interest to process your contact details.

We process personal data for the subsequent conclusion of a contractual relationship.

V. Categories of personal data

In most cases, we process personal data, that you have filled in, as part of a form or contract.

We can also process data from publicly available records and sources.

VI. Recipients of personal data

We do not provide your personal data to third parties.

VII. Period of storage of personal data

In accordance with the periods specified in the relevant contracts, in the file and shredding regulations of the administrator or in the relevant legal regulations, this is absolutely the time necessary to ensure the rights and obligations arising both from the contractual relationship and from the relevant legal regulations.

VIII. Rights of data subjects and obligations of the administrator

You have the right to access your personal data. This means that, upon request, you have the right to receive information (confirmation) from us as to whether or not your personal data is being processed and, if so, you have the right to receive this personal data and at the same time you have the right to receive the following information:

- processing purposes,
- category of personal data concerned,
- recipients or categories of recipients to whom personal data has been or will be made available,
- the planned period for which personal data will be stored,
- all available information about the source of personal data, if not obtained from the data subject.



If you believe that we are processing inaccurate data, you can exercise your right to rectification. If you notify us that you require the correction of your personal data, we are obliged to deal with your request.

In other words, the right to erasure is our obligation to dispose of your personal data if at least one condition is met:

- personal data are no longer needed for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed,
- you revoke consent and there is no other legal reason for processing,
- you object to the processing and there are no overriding legitimate reasons for the processing,
- personal data were processed unlawfully,
- personal data must be deleted to comply with a legal obligation,
- personal data were collected in connection with the offer of information society services in accordance with Article 8, paragraph 1 of the General Regulation.
- The right to erasure is therefore only applied in the read-out points, i.e., when the given circumstance occurs.

The right to erasure is not an absolute right that would give you the opportunity to request erasure of personal data at any time and in any situation. It is not possible, for example, within the framework of this right to request the disposal of all personal data, as we are subject to obligations to further preserve some personal data.

You have the right to restrict the processing of personal data if:

- you deny the accuracy of the personal data, for the time required for us to verify the accuracy of the personal data,
- the processing is unlawful, and you refuse the erasure of personal data and instead request the restriction of their use,
- we no longer need your personal data for processing purposes, but you require it for the determination, exercise or defence of legal claims,
- you intend to exercise the right to object to the processing of personal data.

The essence of the right to portability (this right does not apply to processing necessary for the fulfilment of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of public authority entrusted to the controller) is the possibility, under certain conditions, to obtain the personal data you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and in a machine-readable format, and the right to transfer this data to another administrator, if technically feasible.

General conditions for the application of the right to portability:

- it must be processing based on consent to processing or a contract,
- processing is performed automatically.



The rights and freedoms of other persons must not be adversely affected by the exercise of the right to portability.

If the processing of personal data is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw this consent.
